Since 1985, the PCMA Foundation has been dedicated to advancing the business events industry by providing scholarships, funding research, and delivering essential resources. Through collective fundraising efforts, the Foundation has awarded over 2,900 scholarships and contributed over \$1M USD annually to initiatives that propel the global business events industry forward.

In 2024 alone, the Foundation awarded more than 200 scholarships, expanding educational opportunities for students and building vital connections with industry leaders. \$300,000 USD was directed toward research and educational projects, enabling the community to adapt to emerging trends and challenges. Additionally, the Foundation contributed \$45,000 USD to support four charities.


The PCMA Foundation invested \$300,000 USD in research and education programs to support critical learning initiatives that empower the PCMA community and advance the business events industry.

## **EVENT ACCESSIBILITY AUDIT**

An Event Accessibility Audit at edUcon was funded as part of PCMA's commitment to becoming a leader in event inclusivity. The audit, conducted by Made Welcome consultancy, highlighted both challenges and opportunities in creating accessible temporary event environments, offering actionable recommendations to enhance inclusivity for all attendees. This

initiative demonstrates PCMA's dedication to setting a standard for inclusive events, fostering a more welcoming environment for diverse audiences.

The insights have already informed event design for Convening Leaders and will be shared broadly to inspire and guide the industry toward greater accessibility.



#### PCMA BEST IN CLASS PROGRAM

The PCMA Best in Class Program is funded annually to support individual PCMA chapters in hosting educational events. These events feature highly regarded speakers recognized as 'best in class' within the business events industry, providing participants with top-tier knowledge and valuable insights on current trends and best practices in events.

In 2025, the program will be rebranded as the PCMA Leading Class Program, aligned with the Foundation's mission to inspire continuous growth, leadership development, and cutting-edge content across the industry.
